Information Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Recipient's name, account name and home address</li><li>- Recipient's International Bank Account Number (IBAN) or Bank Account Number</li><li>- The SWIFT or BIC code of their bank. This code is unique to each bank around the world. Sometimes you can be asked for a BIC and sometimes a SWIFT – they are the same thing. Don't worry if you don't have it, Noor Bank has a 'Find a SWIFT/BIC' feature that can help you out.</li></ul>
